It's Christmas Concert Week. The CSM Christmas Concert is this Thursday at 6:30 pm. We ask that all students be there by 6:00pm and everyone to be seated as soon as possible. The show will be approximately one hour long. Please fill the gym from the front to the back and from the middle to the outside so that we might avoid having empty chairs in the middle of the gymnasium. The Grade 6 class will be hosting à bake sale to raise money for the grade 6 camp. Baked goods can be purchased from 5:45 pm to 6:15 pm and again after the concert from 7:30 pm to 8:00 pm.

In the winter months when the temperature is below -18 C we will have indoor recess before school. Students will be asked to come inside the building - take their boots to their boot rack and backpacks to lockers and get their indoor shoes. Students can then head to the gym.

Winter items are getting mixed up regularly. Please label boots, gloves/mittens, jackets, snow pants etc. with your child's name.
